Sunday, March 5 – Saturday, March 11

THEME: **LISTEN**

LISTEN to the world around you. Relate to what is going on and **respond**.

Sunday

Listen to today's Gospel and the priest's homily and think about how God is speaking to you through these messages. <http://www.usccb.org/bible/readings/030517.cfm>
Write what stood out to you as important.

Tuesday

Choose a current song you like and write down a line or two of the lyrics. Tell what the words mean, and if you think it is a message God wants you to follow or ignore?



Monday

Relax and do nothing for 10-15 minutes. Let the world disappear and listen to the silence in your heart. Think about what you "heard".

Wednesday

Choose someone who is going through a rough time. This week, take the time to listen to them and give them a written note of encouragement. Write what you wrote to them.

Thursday

Make a special point to really **listen** today. Is someone asking for help? Do they need some encouragement or support? Are they gossiping? Was it difficult for you to listen? Share what you heard.

Friday

Listen to the sounds in your home. What sounds are comforting? What sounds are disturbing?

Saturday

Write about something you listened to/learned in Religion class. How is it important to you and your everyday life?
