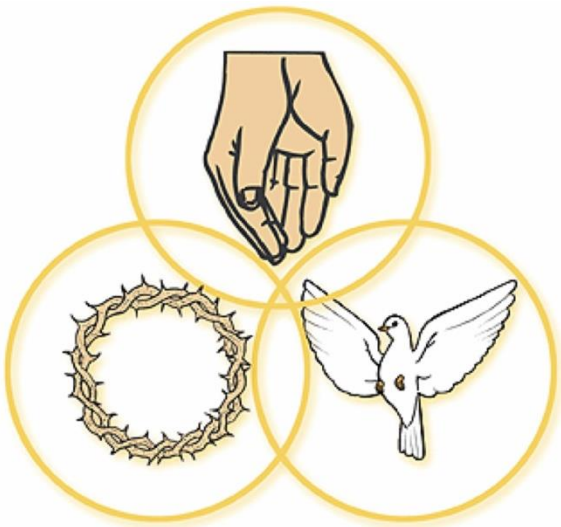


February Supplemental Learning



LIVING THE TRINITY

The Bible teaches us that God is three unique persons, yet he is ONE GOD. He is God the FATHER, God the SON (Jesus), and God the HOLY SPIRIT. We call this the Trinity.

Level K is just beginning their faith journey and learning about God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit. The Trinity is very hard to understand for them, and even for us as adults.

So, how do we teach them to live the Trinity in their lives? In one word...LOVE!
